AEC Schools/ JC are conducting Skill test and Demo Teaching class for engaging teachers on contract basis against the current and anticipated leave/regular vacancies during the year 2025-26 for the following posts.

Qualifications

1. PGT:

a) For Panel -1:

Educational Qualification: Master's degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms) in the subjects concerned.

OR

Integrated Post Graduate Course of Regional Institute of Education of NCERT or any other recognized institute in the following subjects concerned with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/ institution's norms).

Teaching Qualification: B.Ed. from a recognized university. Candidates with B. Ed.-Special Education are not eligible.

b) For Panel- 2:

Candidates without B.Ed., but having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects (55% marks in case of Humanities and Commerce in Post-Graduation) can also apply.

The subject/ Combination of Subjects for PGT is as follows:

1	PGT (English)	Post-Graduation in English
2	PGT (Biology)	Post-Graduation in Botany/Zoology/Life Sciences/ Biosciences /Genetics / Micro Biology/ Bio-Technology/ Molecular Biology. Post-Graduation in Plant Physiology is also eligible provided they have studied Botany or Zoology at Graduation level.
3	PGT (Chemistry)	Post-Graduation in Chemistry / Biochemistry
4	PGT (Mathematics)	Post-Graduation in Mathematics / Applied Mathematics.
5	PGT (Physics)	Post-Graduation in Physics / Electronics/ Applied Physics/ Nuclear Physics

- c) Proficiency in teaching in English medium is required.
- d) Working knowledge of computers (MS Office) is desirable.

2. TGT:

a) For Panel- 1

Educational Qualification:

Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) in the following subject(s) concerned / combination of subjects concerned.

OR

Four years integrated degree course – B.A.Ed. or B.Sc.Ed. from Regional College of Education of NCERT/ from any National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's /institution's norms) in the following subject(s) concerned / combination of subjects concerned.

Teaching Qualification:

- (i) B.Ed. from a recognized university; and
- (ii) Qualifying in Paper-II of Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

b) For Panel- 2:

Candidates with all the qualification same as for the Panel-1 but without CTET.

c) For Panel- 3:

Candidates without B.Ed. and without CTET, but having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects (55% marks in case of Humanities and Commerce in Post-Graduation) can also apply.

Sc.</p>
4	TGT (Maths-Phy)	Mathematics & Physics as subjects in all the three years of graduation.

5	TGT (Chem-Bio)	Chemistry and anyone of Botany or Zoology as subjects in all the three years of graduation.
6	TGT (Marathi)	Marathi as a subject in graduation in all the three years.
7	TGT-PET	Three years Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which the degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/ institution's norms). Teaching qualification not essential.

- d) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.
e) Working knowledge of computers (MS Office) and Hindi is desirable.

3. PRT -EMS:

a) For Panel-1:

Educational Qualification: Pass in Senior Secondary/ Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination or Intermediate or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms) with English as subject in +2 level.

Teaching Qualification:

- (i) Two years Diploma in Elementary Education (D. El. Ed.)/Four years Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) or equivalent.
(ii) Qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper-I) conducted by the CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

For PRT- Music:

Educational Qualification: Bachelor's Degree in Music from a recognized University/Institute with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms).

OR

Equivalent degree of not less than 3 years duration (Music as an elective/ major subject for minimum three years) with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms).

Teaching qualification: not essential for PRT Music.

For PRT- Marathi:

a) For Panel-1:

Educational Qualification: Marathi as an elective/ core subject in Senior Secondary/ Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination or Intermediate or its equivalent passing with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms) with English as subject in +2 level.

Teaching Qualification:

- (i) Two years Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.)/Four years Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education (B. El. Ed.) or equivalent.
- (ii) Qualified in Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) (Paper-I) conducted by the CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

b) For Panel-2:

Candidates with all the qualification same as for the Panel-1 but without CTET can apply.

c) For Panel- 3:

Graduates in relevant subjects having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects (55% marks in case of Humanities) but with no teaching qualification can apply for the post of PRT.

d) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

e) Working knowledge of computers (MS Office) and Hindi is desirable.

4.BAL-VATIKA:**a) For Panel- 1:**

Educational Qualification: Pass in Senior Secondary / Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination or Intermediate or its equivalent with a minimum of 50% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University/ Institution's norms) with English as subject in +2 level.

Teaching Qualification: Diploma in Nursery Teachers Education / Pre-School Education / Early Childhood Education Programme (D.E.C.Ed) of duration of not less than two years, or B.Ed. (Nursery) from National Council for Teacher Education recognized Institution.

b) For Panel- 2:

Graduates in relevant subjects having 60% and above marks in case of Science subjects (55% marks in case of Humanities) but with no teaching qualification can apply for the post of BV Teacher.

c) Proficiency in teaching in English medium.

d) Working knowledge of computers (MS Office) and Hindi is desirable.

MODE OF EMPANELEMENT & SELECTION

Contract teachers will be empaneled based on their performance in the skill test and practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching Class). The respective panel in each category viz. PGT, TGT, PRT and BV teachers will be operated in sequential order.

TERMS OF APPOINTMENT

- (i) The payment of remuneration shall be consolidated pay as per the post for all contract teachers (Scholastic/Non-Scholastic/Co Scholastic teachers) irrespective of their workload. If the number of periods is less, the head of the school will assign other work related to school and use the services of the contract teacher fruitfully, including substitution/data entry/office work etc.
- (ii) The performance of the contract teachers will be evaluated on the same parameters as the regular teachers.
- (iii) The services of a contract teacher will be terminated with one day notice in case of dissatisfactory performance.
- (iv) The contract teachers shall be eligible for one day paid leave per month.
- (v) The Heads of School can use the services of the contract teacher (Prep Teachers/PRT/TGT/PGT) in Primary, Secondary or Senior Secondary sections as per need/emergency. However, the teacher will be paid only as per his/her entitlement.

General Instructions

1. Candidates will have to furnish the complete bio-data giving details of age, qualification, experience and address for correspondence with contact numbers, e-mail id and a passport size photograph in the form provided at the test centre.
2. The candidate must bring a set of attested photocopies of all mark sheets and certificates to be attached with their application.
3. Candidates must bring the original certificates on the day of the test. Candidates not bringing the original certificates will not be allowed to appear for the written test.
4. Candidates must submit separate applications for each post, if applying for more than one post.
5. Candidates whose qualifying examination results are awaited may also apply. They will be considered subject to submitting proof of acquiring desired qualifications at the time of the test
6. No TA/DA is admissible for attending the test for the candidates.
7. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
